<b>SHIRTS</b>    <b>School Logo</b>	Royal Blue or Yellow	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Polo style shirts with school logo/patch</li> <li>• Tab collar t-shirts with school logo/patch</li> <li>• Long sleeve tab collar t-shirt with school logo/patch</li> <li>• School team, club and sport shirts are allowed but must be associated with Glades Middle School or Miami-Dade County Public Schools</li> </ul> <p><b>SCHOOL LOGO/PATCH IS MANDATORY ON ALL SHIRTS ON TEAM &amp; CLUB SHIRTS MAY BE WORN ON FRIDAYS</b></p> <p><b>P.E. SHIRTS ARE ONLY TO BE WORN DURING P.E. CLASS</b></p> <p><b>NO OVERSIZED SHIRTS ALLOWED</b></p>
<b>UNDERSHIRTS</b>	Royal Blue, Yellow, or White	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Undershirt must not be exposed from the sleeves (unless it is a long sleeve undershirt)</li> <li>• Undershirt must not be exposed from the bottom of the uniform shirt (must be tucked in)</li> </ul> <p><b>NO OVERSIZED UNDERSHIRTS ALLOWED</b></p>
<b>STUDENT SCHOOL ID</b>	By Grade Level	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• For safety measures, all students will be required to wear school ID around their neck with a lanyard that opens immediately if someone pulls by accident.</li> <li>• The first ID will cost \$2.00 includes picture &amp; lanyard with specific safety guidelines.</li> <li>• If a student loses their ID, the replacement will cost \$2.00 and student is to inform their homeroom teacher &amp; main office.</li> </ul>
<b>PANTS</b>	Khaki or Navy Blue	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Must fit at waist and go to the ankle</li> <li>• Undergarment <b>must not</b> be exposed</li> </ul> <p>The following items <b>ARE NOT ALLOWED</b>:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ <b>NO JEANS</b>, Pajama, sweat and jogging pants, <b>blue/khaki/black jeggings, and leggings</b></li> </ul> <p><b>OVERSIZED PANTS, CARGO PANTS AND/OR PANTS HANGING BELOW THE WAIST ARE NOT ALLOWED</b></p>
<b>SHORTS/SKIRTS/SKORTS</b>	Khaki or Navy Blue	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Must fit at waist</li> <li>• Must be a reasonable length (extend below outstretched arms and fingers)</li> </ul> <p>The following items <b>ARE NOT ALLOWED</b>:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ P.E., gym, sweat and jean shorts</li> </ul>
<b>SWEATERS</b>	Royal Blue, Navy Blue, Black, Grey	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Zipped at the front (<b>no closed sweaters or long sleeves</b>)</li> <li>• No hooded sweaters</li> <li>• Plain colors (No Print except school logo, College, or brand)</li> </ul>
<b>SHOES</b>		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• All shoes must be closed-toe</li> <li>• No shoes should be open in the back</li> <li>• Laces and straps must be tied and secured</li> </ul> <p>The following items <b>ARE NOT ALLOWED</b>:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ High heels, Wedges, Platforms, Sandals, Slippers, or Crocs</li> </ul>
<b>JEWELRY</b>		<p>The following items <b>ARE NOT ALLOWED</b>:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ Thick neck chains, Pocket Chains or Large Hoop Earrings</li> <li>➤ As a safety measure, body piercing is not allowed (except for ears)</li> </ul> <p>Anything that is a safety or distraction to the learning environment will be asked to be removed.</p>
<b>GROOMING</b>		<p>Please make sure that make-up or hair coloring does not distract the learning environment.</p> <p>*Please read school board policy 5511 located in the District's website. <a href="http://www.dadeschools.net">www.dadeschools.net</a> under the tab "School Board", click on "Board Policies, click on "Adopted Policies", click on "5000 Students", then "5511 Dress Code and School Uniforms". An explanation will be provided.</p>
