REMINDERS

Attendance Policy

- Students cannot miss more than 10 days in a school year. For the first 5 days, a parent must email Cecilia Gonzalez with the student's name, ID number, and a valid excuse for their absence. After the 5th absence, a doctor's note **must** be included in the email. In addition, absence notes can be dropped off in the Main Office between 8:00 am-9:00 am.

Tardy Policy

After 9:10 am (upon ringing of the 2nd bell) you must walk your child to the office for a late pass.

Uniform Policy

- All students must wear a school shirt with logo, khaki/beige pants or Bermudas, closed shoes, and Student ID daily.
- Only Black, Blue, or Gray sweaters are allowed.
- Air Pods and phones are not allowed in class. Students will be directed to silence their phones, remove air pods or any headphones, and store them in their book bags. It is a disruption to the learning environment.
- During lunchtime, students will be allowed to have access to their phones. However, if it becomes a disruption to the school's learning environment, they face losing this privilege, as a consequence.

COMMUNICABLE DISEASES


- Florida Statute 381.0031 requires reporting of communicable diseases to the school's administration.
- COVID-19: 5 days absent from school from the first positive test result or from the first day of symptoms. Students and Employees may return to work after the 5th day, provided they have not had fever within the last 24 hours and exhibit no major symptoms. Although masks are not mandatory, please wear a mask if you are sick.
- Monkey Pox, Flu, Stomach Virus, and Pink Eye are considered communicable diseases. Please inform the administration immediately upon noticing any illness.

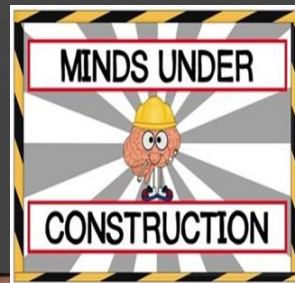

FLORIDA ASSESSMENT OF STUDENT THINKING (FAST)

- FAST is the new Coordinated Screening and Progress Monitoring tool that is computer-adaptive and for all grade levels. This will be administered three times per year in Reading and Math.
- Assessments will be aligned to B.E.S.T. Standards
- Tests will be computer-adaptive through the Test Delivery System (TDS) secure browser.

FAST Progress Monitoring (PM) Windows:

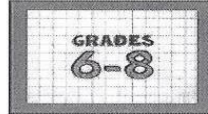
- PM1: September 6th -15th
- PM 2: January- February
- PM 3: May (Achievement Level Assigned)

Unit of Study on Reproductive Health and Disease Education

- According to Florida Statutes, Miami-Dade County Public Schools is required to provide instruction on **Reproductive Health and Disease Education**.
- In Grades 6-8, this instruction takes place through a unit of study in your child's **Science class** and is provided in a factual, academic, and age-appropriate manner.
- An opt-out letter will be sent home in the Spring providing information on how to view the instructional materials that will be used during the lessons and what topics will be covered at each grade level.
- If a parent wants to **opt their child out of this instruction**, they must complete, sign, and return the letter to his/her child's teacher. The child will be provided with alternate assignments and will not be penalized for not participating in this instruction.
