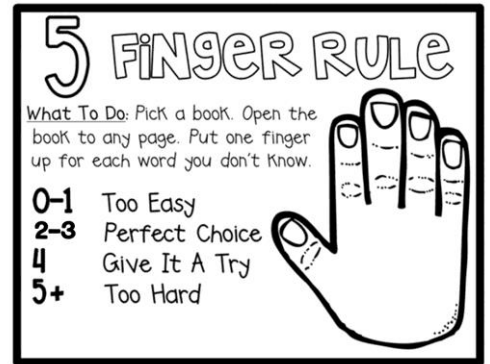


**Use the link <http://read.dadeschools.net/indexsec.html> to find ebooks and audiobooks for all interest & Reading levels. We're sure you'll find something you'll love! Select 1 book or audiobook for your summer reading activities.**

Follow these guidelines when selecting your book:

- Make sure it is a middle school book (grades 6-8)
- You can select an audiobook through Audible.com
- Use the 5 finger rule to guide you



After you select your book or audio book complete two of the following activities:

- Create a Meme for each book that you have read or one Meme that combines all the books.
- Using Office 365 write a one-page "pitch" to a producer explaining why the story would or would not make a great movie.
- Using Office 365 write a paragraph telling about the title. Is it appropriate? Why not? If you feel it is not appropriate, provide an alternate title and explain why this title is better.
- Look through online magazines for words and pictures that describe your book. Use these to create a virtual collage
- Visit the author's official website to conduct research and write your findings in one page (minimum). Include pictures of the author.
- Create and write and advice column giving the author of the book advice on how they should handle the problems/ dilemmas in the text.
- Create a TOP Ten List in which you write and illustrate events or ideas you learned from the book.
