#### It's the Law!

To ensure a focused learning environment and comply with state/school policy, all cell phones are **strictly prohibited** from being used during school hours.

#### Where Do Cell Phones Go?

All cell phones <u>must be stored inside your bookbags</u> from the moment you enter school grounds until the final bell rings. Cell phones cannot be in your pockets.

#### **No Exceptions**

Students are <u>not permitted to use their cellphones</u> at any time while on school property. This includes hallways, classrooms, and the cafeteria. If you need to call your parents, go to the Main Office or Student Services.

• CONSEQUENCES: Failure to adhere to this policy will result in student's cell phone or electronic device being confiscated by administrators, staff, or teachers. - M/J Language Arts Through ESOL is a required course for all ELs. ELs scoring at Levels 1 and 2 on the most recent administration of the statewide, standardized ELA assessment are to be enrolled in a second ESOL course, M/J Developmental Language Through ESOL course.
