


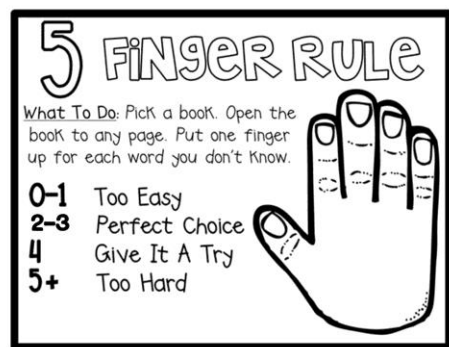
## GLADES GATOR'S SUMMER READING

Follow these guidelines when selecting your book:

- Make sure it is a middle school book (grades 6-8)
- Use the 5-finger rule to guide you. 
- [RISING 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> graders were given specific novels and will be using that book and paired journal. Rising 7<sup>th</sup> will read, "Sarah, Plain and Tall" and Rising 8<sup>th</sup> will read, "The Little Prince"](#)



**After you select your book complete TWO of the following activities:**

- Create a Meme for the plot (story line) of your book.
- Design a movie poster for the novel. Include an important scene as the main image & use details from the story in your text/captions.
- Do you dislike the way the story ended? Write an alternate ending for the book. 1 page minimum
- Look through online magazines for words and pictures that describe your book. Use these to create a virtual collage.
- Write a letter to the author of your novel. Include your opinion of the text as well as suggestions to make improve the story.
- Create and write an advice column giving the author of the book advice on how they should handle the problems/ dilemmas in the text.
- Create a TOP Ten List in which you write and illustrate events or ideas you learned from the book.
